## **Falcon Highlands Park**

Falcon Highlands Metropolitan District has completed renovation of the park. The improvements included updating some of the playground equipment, eliminating the native grass areas and adding pergolas.

## **Falcon Highlands Sidewalk, Curb and Roadway Project**

Falcon Highlands Metropolitan District met with El Paso County back in 2017 and discussed areas of concern regarding concrete and road issues that were present in the community. The county indicated that they would prioritize the curb and sidewalk work based upon budget. During the last part of 2020, funds came available and a contract was let to Pyramid Construction for ~\$2.5M. The county descended upon Falcon Highlands with fervor and now we are in the healing mode. Ongoing supply shortages are contributing to delay in completion of this project.

## **Falcon Highland Common Area**

The common areas to the east, west, and south of this development are present for utility easement, drainage, and hiking trails. This land should never be used to ride ATVs or dirt bikes, as motorized vehicles cause damage to the trails that takes years to heal. Such activity also disturbs the peacefulness of our neighborhood. Additionally, vehicles should not be parked on FHMD property for any reason or time. The District will take necessary legal action against trespassers. Please help this effort by keeping the common areas clear of vehicles, RVs and trailers, and reporting any suspicious activity to the Sheriff's office.

## **Rolling Thunder**

The District Board of Directors is requesting a traffic study of Rolling Thunder from El Paso County. Blind curve conditions warrant a review; addition of a four-way stop or a reduction in speed limit are both options we hope will be considered to increase safety for the community, especially at or near the Antelope Meadows and Indian Echo intersections with Rolling Thunder now that usage has increased with the completion of New Meridian Road. Remember to drive safe!
