Summary of Water Conservation and Restriction Policies

Water Conservation Policy (effective at all times):

- Spray irrigation is limited to 3 days per week and 2,500 square feet of irrigated area.
 - o Even numbered addresses spray Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday.
 - o Odd numbered addresses spray Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday.
 - o No spray irrigation permitted on Friday.
 - o Spray irrigation is only allowed between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.
- No limit on days, area, or frequency of drip irrigation.
- No limit on hand watering for annual and edible plantings.
- Car washing permitted with shut-off nozzle hose and bucket.
- No washing of impermeable surfaces, including driveways and sidewalks.
- All watering must be done in a manner to prevent water waste and overwatering.
 - o No pooling in gutters, streets or alleys.
 - o No spray on concrete or asphalt.
 - o No watering during rain or high wind.
- Special allowance permit to establish new landscaping in April, May, September, or October: \$100 fee to water four days per week for four weeks, limited to one inch of water per zone.
- Violations subject a property to penalty on a single-family equivalent (SFE) basis.
 - o 1st violation = written warning.
 - o 2nd violation = \$100 fine per SFE.
 - o 3rd violation = \$200 fine per SFE.
 - o Continued violations = \$300 fine per SFE and suspension of service (service is reinstated after outstanding balance and \$100 reconnection fee are paid in full).

Temporary Restriction Policy (when ordered by the District):

- From time to time, the District may order Level 1 or Level 2 temporary restrictions during scheduled and unscheduled maintenance or other events causing a need to reduce water consumption on a temporary basis.
 - o Level 1 – no commercial irrigation. No impact on residential irrigation.
 - o Level 2 – no commercial or residential irrigation.
- Violation of Level 1 or Level 2 restriction subjects property to penalty.
 - o 1st violation = written warning.
 - o 2nd violation = \$1,000 fine.
 - o 3rd violation = \$10,000 fine and suspension of service (service is reinstated after outstanding balance and \$100 reconnection fee are paid in full).
